Vessel examiners go to various boat ramps and, upon request, to a private home to examine vessels to make certain that all safety equipment is on board and that it is in good condition and updated, from registrations to signal flairs.

Flotilla 3-8 has nine examiners at the present time and expect to increase that number this year. The main purpose of the VE Program is not only to ensure safer vessels on the water but also to educate the boat owner.

As soon as the new forms and decals for 2010 are received, a VE Blitz will be scheduled at John U. Lloyd State Park boat ramp.
